



#### Social


Communication connects people in groups of shared beliefs, parasocial interactions



It is important for Canadians to have a regular health care provider in the community and to be able to access this care when needed. Providers such as family doctors or nurse practitioners provide routine care for chronic and minor medical conditions, and these providers can refer patients to specialists.<sup>[1]</sup>

The data we have on primary care in Canada indicates an unmet need for this kind of care in the community.

of these could potentially be managed virtually



Percent who worry, in Canada



2025 Edelman Trust Barometer P. 17


#### In Canada, No News Sources Trusted


