New for vegetation management

Active ingredient flazasulfuron

Developed by ISK in the 1980's

Registered in Asia, Europe, USA

Registered in Canada May 2018

Received classification in Ontario in September

Low use rates, ideal for sensitive markets

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Flazasulfuron

- Systemic, residual herbicide
- Granular formulation, 25% A.I.
- Inhibits the enzyme acetolactate synthase (ALS)
- Once applied, target plants cease growth
- Visible symptoms, leaf discoloration and necrosis occur in the following weeks
- Controls both pre-emergent and post-emergent weeds and grasses

Flazasulfuron

- Low toxicity
 - Acute...5000mg/kg
- Granular formulation makes for easy clean up
- Minimal PPE requirements



- Application rates are 150 to 200 grams/ha
- Water volumes:
 - Volume range 150L to 450L/ha
 - Ground sprays recommend 200L/ha
- REI'S
 - Katana - 12 hours
 - Longrun – sprays have dried
 - Always follow most restrictive REI in tank mix



- Forestry uses: site-preparation, conifer release & Christmas trees
- First new active ingredient registered in forestry in many years
- Residual activity
- Spray in the fall, plant in the spring
- Initially ground applications only, aerial to come
